- Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 326, Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford MK42 9AP no later than Friday, 12 April 2019. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
- Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford MK42 9AP by 5.00pm on Monday, 15 April 2019, if they are to be effective for this election.
- Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford MK42 9AP by 5pm on Wednesday, 24 April 2019 if they are to be effective for this election.
- Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Borough Hall, Cauldwell Street, Bedford MK42 9AP by 5.00pm on Thursday, 2 May 2019.
